



Mentoring: Helping Students Create a Career in Pharmacy

Activity Description:

Students often look to their preceptors for guidance in skills beyond daily practice. In this knowledge-based continuing pharmacy education activity, preceptors can gain insight into the areas in which students are seeking input. Among them are career opportunities and pathways, work/life balance and financial planning. In addition, preceptors can be key in helping students understand the importance of giving back to the profession and overall professionalism.
